MEMBERS PRESENT	Committee members present: Tom Klitzka and Barry Keller. Others present - David Crawford, Jeff Hallinan. Invited guest Mayor Don McIlroy and Auditor Mark Bidwell.
1. MEETING MINUTES	Klitzka motioned to accept the minutes for 07-20-2021 and 08-03-20. Keller seconded. Motion carried.

2. a) An Ordinance Levying Assessments For Outstanding Delinquent Water And/Or Sewer Bills On Certain Utilities Accounts

Hedges stated this is a routine ordinance that comes twice a year for assessments for delinquent bills in the Utility Dept. that are in arrears. This is an extensive list of twenty-four property owners.
Keller motioned to forward the ordinance to the September 7, 2021, Council meeting with a recommendation for approval. Klitzka seconded. Roll Call. (3 Yeas - 0 Nays). Motion carried.

b.) An Ordinance Establishing Section 301.57 And 373.13 And Amending Provisions In Chapter 373 Of The Codified Ordinances Of The City Of Circleville To Include Provisions Relating To Low-Speed Micro Mobility Devices Or Electric Scooters And Declaring An Emergency. (Electric Scooters rules and regulations).

Hedges stated this ordinance is from the Safety Dept. One of the highlights is this prohibits the use of scooters on City's sidewalks. Keller asked why the changes? Hedges explained it is because of the passage of the DORA and more foot traffic on the sidewalks and safety issues. The Mayor concluded that the scooters are identified as bicycle and are not allowed on sidewalks, but a person can ride a scooter on walking or bike paths. Klitzka asked about handicap scooters? The Mayor stated the handicap scooters are not included in this ordinance. Hallinan asked about age requirements to ride the scooters? The Mayor stated there has not been any reports of underage persons riding the scooter. Josh Cross, 621 North Court St explained the scooters are not allowed on the sidewalks. There is a sticker placed on the scooters that states that. Cross stated the Bird policy is a scooter rider needs to be eighteen years or older to rent these.
Klitzka motioned to forward the ordinance to the September 7, 2021, Council meeting with a recommendation for approval. Keller seconded the motion. Roll Call. (3 Yeas - 0 Nays). Motion carried.

c.) An Ordinance Amending Section 741.51 Of The Codified Ordinances Of The City Of Circleville Relating To The Allocation Of Funds Deposited Into The Circleville Cable Television Special Revenue Fund #211 And Declaring An Emergency.

Auditor Bidwell stated currently that funds franchise has 50% to CGTV fund and 50% to the General funds. This ordinance will change the percentage to 100% into the to CGTV -5 account. This will allow the CGTV Director to purchase a vehicle to be used by the Circleville cable television station, also there is not an end date on the ordinance. Keller asked if the current vehicle is usable? The Mayor stated it is in bad shape and at end of its life and needs to be replaced. Keller stated it will take a separate ordinance to finance this vehicle to make the purchase, this ordinance needs to be referred to the Finance Cmte.
Klitzka motioned to forward the ordinance to the next the Finance Cmte. meeting to review. Keller seconded. Roll Call. (3 Yeas - 0 Nays). Motion carried.

3. Application for a Board or Commission - Approval of application for Board of Zoning Appeals

Hedges stated this is an BZA application (Dennis Garlington) to fill an alternate one-year term position that is vacant on the BZA Board.

Hedges states she needs a verbal vote to forward this application to Council meeting tonight to be voted on. Voice Vote. (3 Yeas - 0 Nays).

4. Adjournment

Klitzka motioned to adjourn the meeting at 6:25 pm. Keller seconded. Motion carried.
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
