Circleville City Council convened in City Council Chambers Tuesday September 7, 2021, at 7:00 pm. Roll call, members present: David Crawford, Council President; Michelle Blanton, At Large; Katie Logan Hedges, At Large; Tom Klitzka, At Large; Jeff Hallinin, First Ward; Barry Keller, Second Ward; Todd Brady, Third Ward; Sheri Theis, Fourth Ward; and Linda Chancey, Clerk. Invited guests Mayor Don McIlroy and Law Director Gary Kenworthy

President Crawford called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited, and invocation was given by all. Crawford stated that the August 17, 2021, minutes are filed as recorded.

REPORTS FROM COUNCIL MEMBERS

- Crawford stated that prior to tonight's Council meeting there was a Cmte of Whole meeting to discuss a proposed strategic growth fiscal analysis with Ryan Scribner, who discussed the merit of this plan. There will be a Cmte of Whole September 21st at 6:45 pm to discuss this plan. The second item discussed was the American Reuse Fund dollars granted to municipalities for Covid mediation. The Mayor discussed projects that can be funded with these funds.

ORDINANCES FOR FIRST READING

An Ordinance Levying Assessments For Outstanding Delinquent Water And/Or Sewer Bills On Certain Utilities Accounts. Hedges stated this was reviewed in the Judicial Cmte. Hedges explained this is housekeeping for outstanding delinquent water and/or sewer bills and for assessments on the property. Hedges motioned to suspend the rules. Hallinin seconded. Roll call. (7 Yeas -0 Nays). Rules are Suspended. Hedges motioned for passage. Keller seconded. Roll call. (7 Yeas -0 Nays). Ordinance passes and assigned # 09-41-2021.

An Ordinance Establishing Section 301.57 And 373.13 And Amending Provisions In Chapter 373 Of The Codified Ordinances Of The City Of Circleville To Include Provisions Relating To Low-Speed Micro Mobility Devices Or Electric Scooters And Declaring An Emergency.

Hedges stated this was reviewed in the Judicial Cmte. Hedges explained this is to address the scooters that are not allowed on the sidewalks but allowed on the City's trails behind O.C.U, there was no bearing on

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the personal mobility scooters Hedges motioned to suspend the rules. Theis seconded. Roll call. (7 Yeas -0 Nays). Rules are Suspended. Hedges motioned for passage. Klitzka seconded. Roll call. (7 Yeas -0 Nays). Ordinance passes and assigned # 09-42-2021.

An Ordinance Amending The Annual Appropriation Ordinance In The General Government Fund 101 And Safety Forces .5% Tax Fund 212 Of The City of Circleville. Keller stated this was reviewed in the Finance Cmte and was recommended for passage. Keller explained this is an appropriation of dollars in the police and fire departments. Keller motioned to suspend the rules. Blanton seconded. Roll call. (7 Yeas -0 Nays). Rules are Suspended. Keller motioned for passage. Brady seconded. Roll call. (7 Yeas -0 Nays). Ordinance passes and assigned # 09-43-2021.

An Ordinance Providing For The Issue And Sale Of Notes In The Maximum Principal Amount Of \$1.5 Million, In Anticipation Of The Issue Of Bonds For The Purpose Of Paying The Cost Of Improving The City's Parks And Recreational Facilities And Declaring An Emergency. Keller stated this was reviewed in the Finance Cmte and was recommended for passage. Keller explained this is borrowing note of 1.5 million for improving Ted Lewis Park. Keller motioned to suspend the rules. Brady seconded. Roll call. (7 Yeas -0 Nays). Rules are Suspended. Brady motioned for passage. Blanton seconded. Roll call. (7 Yeas -0 Nays). Ordinance passes and assigned # 09-44-2021.

An Ordinance To Improve Sidewalks On North Court Street And Declaring An Emergency. Keller stated this was reviewed in the Finance Cmte and the Safety Cmte and was recommended for passage. Keller explained the cmte reviewed for the necessity of improvement to the city curbs and sidewalks and potential removal of three trees. This will be an assessment project when completed. Keller motioned to suspend the rules. Hallinin. Roll call. (7 Yeas -0 Nays). Rules are Suspended. Keller motioned for passage. Brady seconded. Roll call. (7 Yeas -0 Nays). Ordinance passes and assigned # 09-45-2021.

UNDER NEW BUSINESS

Blanton motioned to appoint Matthew Tootle to OhioHealth/Berger Oversight Board. Klitzka seconded. Motion carried.

Hallinin motioned to adjourn the meeting at 7:47 pm. Brady seconded Meeting adjourned
