Circleville City Council convened in City Council Chambers Tuesday September 21, 2021, at 7:00 pm. Roll call, members present: David Crawford, Council President; Katie Logan Hedges, At Large; Tom Klitzka, At Large; Jeff Hallinin, First Ward; Barry Keller, Second Ward; Todd Brady, Third Ward; Sheri Theis, Fourth Ward; and Linda Chancey, Clerk and Darci Valentine, Assistant Clerk. President Crawford called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited, and invocation was given by all. Crawford stated that the September 7, 2021, minutes are filed as recorded.

REPORTS FROM COUNCIL MEMBERS

- Keller announced a Finance Cmte mtg Tuesday, October 5th at 6:00 pm.

- Crawford stated that prior to tonight's Council meeting there was a Cmte of Whole meeting. ORDINANCES FOR FIRST READING

An Ordinance To Adopt The Revised Fee Schedule For The Fire Department Inspections And Reviews. Hedges stated this was original for the Safety Cmte. Hedges explained this is bringing the fee schedule inspection for Fire Dept with comparable surrounding communities. Hedges motioned to suspend the rules. Brady seconded. Roll call. (6 Yeas -0 Nays). Rules are Suspended. Brady motioned for passage. Theis seconded. Roll call. (6 Yeas -0 Nays). Ordinance passes and assigned # 09-46-2021.

An Ordinance Authorizing The Director Of Public Safety To Advertise For Bids And Enter Into A Contact With The Lowest And Best Bidder For The Purchase Or Lease Or Three Uniform Marked Police Safety Vehicles For The Department Of Public Safety Division Of Police Or To Utilize The State And Federal Purchase Programs Which Is The Most Lucrative Purchase And Declaring An Emergency. Hedges stated this was original for the Safety Cmte. Hedges explained this is asking for three replacement safety vehicles. The new cruisers are Ford SUV models. The current plan is to trade in the current older Dodge Charger's safety vehicles for the new ones. Hedges motioned to suspend the rules. Hallinin seconded. Roll call. (6 Yeas -0 Nays). Rules are suspended. Klitzka motioned for passage. Hallinin seconded. Roll call. (6 Yeas -0 Nays). Ordinance passes and assigned # 09-47-2021.
