

CIRCLEVILLE FINANCE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES 06-20-2023

Circleville City Finance Committee convened in City Council Chambers, 127 South Court St, Circleville, OH. Tuesday, June 20, 2023, at 5:30 pm. Roll call. Present were Chair Michelle Blanton, Committee members Katie Logan Hedges and Todd Brady. Others present Barry Keller; Tom Duvall and Sheri Theis. Invited Guests Mayor Don McIlroy and City Auditor Mark Bidwell.

Brady motioned to approve the June 6, 2023, minutes, Hedges seconded. Motion carried.

An Ordinance Replacing The One-Half Per Cent (1/2%) Income Tax Rate Increase Allocated For The Purpose Of Operating And Maintaining The Safety Forces In The City Of Circleville, To Be A Supplement To The Current Allocation Of Funds To The General Fund And Not A Substitution Of These Funds With A Permanent 0.40% Percent Annum Income Tax Effective January 1, 2025, Directing The Pickaway County Board Of Elections To Submit This Ordinance To The Electors Of The City Pursuant To Ohio Revised Code, Section 718.04 And Declaring An Emergency. This is the replacement ordinance with revisions from the discussion on June 6th Finance meeting.

MOTION-ROLL CALL-VOTE.

Hedges motioned to amend this ordinance permanent clause and change to 5- years clause commencing on January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2029, and forward to City Council Mtg on July 5th for passage. Blanton seconded. Roll call. (2 Yeas- 1 Nay – Brady.)

A Resolution To Submit To The Electors At A General Election To Be Held On November 7, 2023, An Ordinance To Replace The One-Half Per Cent (1/2%) Income 2025, Rate Increase Allocated For The Purposed Of Operating And Maintaining The Safety Forces In The City of Circleville, To Be A Supplement To The Current Allocation Of Funds To The General Fund And Not A Substitution Of These Funds, With A Permanent 0.40% Per Annum Income Tax To Commence January 1,2025, Directing The Pickaway County Board Of Elections To Submit The Tax Ordinance To The Electors Of The City Pursuant To Ohio Revised Code, Section 718.04 And Declaring An Emergency. This is the supplicant to the ordinance that was forwarded to Council with the same revisions. Blanton asked that Section VI for the ballot the word “permanent” be changed to 5-years commencing January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2029.

MOTION-ROLL CALL-VOTE.

Hedges motioned to remove permanent clause and match the dates in the ordinance and forward to City Council July 5, 2023, for passage. Blanton seconded. Roll call. (2 Yeas- 1 Nay - Brady).

An Ordinance Amending The Annual Appropriation Ordinance In The General Fund 101 Legal Research & Computer Maintenance Fund 209 Park Improvement Debt Issuance Fund 252 And Addiction Treatment Grant Fund 267 Of The City Of Circleville. This is a financial housekeeping ordinance for appropriations. The spreadsheet number should be corrected to \$2,000.00.

MOTION-ROLL CALL-VOTE.

Hedges motioned to forward to July 5th City Council meeting with the corrections to \$2,000.00. Brady seconded. Roll call. (3 Yeas- 0 Nays).

Brady motioned to adjourn the meeting at 6:08 p.m. seconded by Hedges. Motion carried.
