- d. **An Ordinance** Replacing The One-Half Per Cent (.50%) Income Tax Rate Increase Allocated For The Purpose Of Operating And Maintaining The Safety Forces In The City Of Circleville, To Be A Supplement To The Current Allocation Of Funds To The General Fund And Not A Substitution Of These Funds With A 0.40% Percent Annum Income Tax for a Five Year Period Effective January 1, 2025, and Expiring December 31,2029 Directing The Pickaway County Board Of Elections To Submit This Ordinance To The Electors Of The City Pursuant To Ohio Revised Code, Section 718.04 And Declaring An Emergency.
