Circleville City Council convened in Council Chambers Wednesday, April 10, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. Roll call, Council members present: President Barry Keller; Katie Logan Hedges, At Large; Sheri Theis, At Large; Tom Klitzka, At Large; Jeff Hallinin, First Ward; John Moats, Second Ward; Zack Brooks, Third Ward; Tom Duvall, Fourth Ward.
