

CIRCLEVILLE JUDICIAL COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES 5/21/2024

Circleville Judicial Committee convened in City Council Chambers, 127 South Court St, Circleville, OH. on Tuesday, May 21, 2024, at 6:45 pm. Roll call: Members present: Chair Tom Klitzka, Committee members Sheri Theis, John Moats, and Clerk Melissa Burns. Other Council members present: Tom Duvall, Jeff Hallinin, and Zach Brooks. Invited guests: Mayor Michelle Blanton,

Klitzka called the meeting to order at 6:45 p.m.

Moats motioned to approve the minutes from May 13, 2024. Seconded by Theis. Motion carried.

New Business:

a) AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF CIRCLEVILLE, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Discussion: This Ordinance is to add various passed Ordinances from April 4, 2023, through April 1, 2024, to the Codified Ordinances. Theis confirmed Exhibit A referenced in the Ordinance will go to the next Council meeting.

Linda Chancey spoke to say the Codified Ordinances are updated once a year to put passed Ordinances in an easy to read format.

MOTION - ROLL CALL - VOTE

Theis motioned to forward this ordinance to the Council meeting June 4, 2024, with a recommendation for passage. Seconded by Moats. Roll call (3 Yeas-0 Nays). Motion carried.

Other Business:

a) Theis stated she would like the zoning code to be revised to include a section about political signs. The code was revised two years ago and the section regarding political signs was missed. The old code allowed signs to be put up 45 days prior to election and removed 48 hours after. Theis would like that same language to be placed back in the code prior to the November election.

b) Tom Verfaillie expressed concerns about the proposed location of the homeless shelter on Morris Road. He is against the proposed location because it would be in his backyard. Klitzka explained there is no set location for the shelter and Hope House is still looking for a place they will be accepted.

Moats motioned to adjourn the meeting at 6:53 p.m. Seconded by Theis. Motion carried.
