

CIRCLEVILLE SERVICE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES 7/30/2024

Circleville City Service Committee convened in City Council Chambers, 127 South Court St, Circleville, OH. Tuesday, July 30, 2024, at 5:30 p.m. Present at Roll Call: Chair Tom Duvall and members Sheri Theis, Zach Brooks, and Clerk Melissa Burns. Other Council members present: Tom Klitzka, John Moats, and Katie Logan Hedges. Brian Frost, Jim Stanley and Mayor Michelle Blanton.

Duvall called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Brooks motioned to approve the minutes from July 16, 2024. Seconded by Theis. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

a) A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TAKE BACK THE STRIP TO USE CITY STREETS FOR THEIR ANNUAL KIDSPALOOZA FOR 2024 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Discussion Jeff Coleman stated this Resolutions is take Back the Strip's annual car show on September 28, 2024. This is a free community event with different activities for the kids. Last year they raised \$1,300 dollars for Pickaway's Toys for Tots and a truck load full of toys.

MOTION-ROLL CALL-VOTE: Theis motioned to forward the Resolution to the next Council meeting on August 6, 2024, with a recommendation for Adoption. Brooks seconded. Roll call (3 Yeas -0 Nays) Motion carried.

b) RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TAKE BACK THE STRIP TO USE CITY STREETS FOR ROCK 4 TOTS FOR 2024 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Discussion TuneStone Productions is a local production house. They've organized over 14 acts to perform inside and outside of Tootles. They will also have bounce houses and touch a truck. This event will also benefit Pickaway County's Toy's for Tots. Admission to the event is an unwrapped toy.

MOTION-ROLL CALL-VOTE: Brooks motioned to forward the Resolution to the next Council meeting on August 6, 2024, with a recommendation for Adoption. Theis seconded. Roll call (3 Yeas -0 Nays) Motion carried.

c) SS4A Presentation presented by Alex Schuler.

Alex Schuler from Strand Associates Inc. presented data for Safe Streets for All (SS4A). Circleville received a grant to complete a safety action plan. Strand will determine through reviewing crash data which street corridors have the highest crash densities in the city. Strand will then evaluate alternatives to make those street corridors safer. Mr. Schuler said part of Strand's process is to hear from the citizens. There is a link posted on the City's website where citizens can voice their opinion through August 12, 2024. Mr. Schuler stated Strand will also give yearly updates after the plan is completed and implemented so the City can track its progress. The Draft Action Plan will be submitted on August 30, 2024, the Completed Action Plan will be submitted on December 31, 2024. The Planned Action Plan will be submitted for adoption on January 31, 2025, and the Final Report will be submitted on March 31, 2025.
