

CIRCLEVILLE SAFETY COMMITTEE MINUTES 9/3/2024

Circleville Safety Committee convened in City Council Chambers, 127 South Court St, Circleville, OH. on Tuesday, September 3, 2024, at 6:15 p.m. Members present: Chair Jeff Hallinin, Committee Members Tom Klitzka, Katie Logan Hedges, and Clerk Melissa Burns. Other Council Members Present: Barry Keller, Sheri Theis, Tom Duvall, Zach Brooks, and John Moats. Invited Guest Present: Mayor Michelle Blanton and Law Director Kendra Kinney.

Hallinin called the meeting to order at 6:15 p.m.

Klitzka motioned to approve the minutes from July 30, 2024. Seconded by Hedges. Motion carried.

New Business

a) AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY BECOME A RESIDENT OF THE CITY WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF APPOINTMENT TO THE POSITION OF DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY, UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS AND REPEALING ORDINANCE #08-52-2003 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

DISCUSSION: Hallinin stated this Ordinance will repeal the previous provision that requires the Director of Public Safety to become a resident within six months of appointment. Hallinin stated this is like the Ordinance previously submitted for the Chief of Police and will be more aligned with the Ohio Revised Code.

Hedges motioned to forward the Ordinance to the next Council meeting on September 17, 2024, with a recommendation for passage. Klitzka seconded. Roll call (3 Yeas- 0 Nays). Motion carried.
