Minutes

Members Present: Beth Mason, Megan Travis, Jim Stanley and Clerk Suzanne Channell. Tyler Cruz was excused.

Beth Mason called meeting to order at 4:32 pm.

Approval of Minutes:

Megan Travis made motion to approve minutes from July 2024 as recorded. Beth Mason seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

President's Report:

Beth Mason Spoke about the parks and where Milt Emerine Park and Ted Lewis Park stand financially year to date. She also stated she was at Barthlemas Park and baseball diamond #6 needs cleaned up. You aren't able to see dirt on the field. Jim Stanley suggested we write a letter to the Circleville Youth Baseball league.

Service Director's Report:

Jim Stanley mentioned there was a new roof on the old restrooms at Ted Lewis. He also stated CT Consultants are beginning to survey Barthelmas Park for the softball fields and general plan out there.

New Business:

Jeff Coleman asked if they could do fundraising to add a pump track at one of the parks. Jim Stanley said he would look into this more when creating a master plan.

Eric Plotts also spoke about getting a track and NICA which is the National Interscholastic Cycling Association and how this could benefit the youth of Pickaway County and surrounding counties.

The Pumpkin Show Parking at Ted Lewis was discussed with Jim Stanley saying there may be designating parking this year depending on when the fields get leveled out and re-seeding is done. Once the fields are regraded no cars can park on them. Jim said it may be a possibility to wait until after the Pumpkin Show to do the grading.

Hannah Wynne was there and spoke about a family movie night at Ted Lewis Park. The movie will start at 7:45 pm and there will be popcorn, water, pizza, games and prizes before the movie begins. Beth Mason made a motion to approve the movie night, seconded by Megan Travis. All in favor, motion carried.

Beth Mason spoke about the Cobb Weese Memorial Award for Coach-of-the-Year. She stated her family gives it out every year as now it will be given out by the Park Board each year. This year the award went to Nate Brooks. Brad McNight spoke about the award and the meaning behind it.

Hannah Wynne mentioned the City is applying for grants for two pieces of property for new parks. One property is on N. Court St. and the other is located at 460 N. Pickaway St. She gave the board a letter of support to sign.

Brad McNight asked about getting a 3-D archery ring at one of the parks like the one they have in Grove City.

Beth Mason made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Megan Travis. Meeting adjourned at 5:11pm.
