Beth Mason called meeting to order at 4:30 pm.

Approval of Minutes:

Megan Travis made motion to approve minutes from August 2024 as recorded. Beth Mason seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

President's Report:

Beth Mason stated field# 6 at Barthelmas Park is cleaned up and looks wonderful. She also stated the Park Board has \$5,000 to spend and would like recommendations on what that could go towards. She is doing her research on a handicap swing.

Dave Horning suggested the money go towards a platform to contact parents in all sports. Jeff Coleman suggested the money go towards the design and estimate of a new pump track. Eric Potts recommended the money be used to get started on a bike path.

Service Director's Report:

Jim Stanley was not present but Hannah Wynne spoke in his place regarding acquisition of (2) properties which she received a letter of support for. She also mentioned they are continuing with water and land conservation fund grant application for the new shelter at Ted Lewis Park. There is going to be a movie night at Ted Lewis Park on September 14th with the movie starting at 7:45 pm.

New Business:

Tonya Wood with the Pickaway County Pickleball Association requested permission to raise funds for a 3rd pickleball court at Barthelmas Park. She said they are planning on raising \$50,000 – 60,000 to get this started. She gave options of how someone can become part of the Pickleball Association.

Beth Mason made a motion to approve them raising funds, seconded by Tyler Cruz. All in favor, motion carried.

Beth Mason made a motion that the City of Circleville can apply for the ODNR grant for funding for the new pickleball court. Seconded by Megan Travis. All in favor, motion carried.

Tyler Cruz talked about putting little libraries in the parks. He said he would find donations for the books and also to construct the boxes.

Jan Shannon asked if the Rotarians could install peace poles at Mary Virginia in their garden. Tyler made a motion to approve, seconded by Megan. All in favor, motion carried.

Beth Mason made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Tyler Cruz. Meeting adjourned at 5:12pm.
