

CIRCLEVILLE JUDICIAL COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES 1/14/2025

Circleville Judicial Committee convened in City Council Chambers, 127 South Court St, Circleville, OH. on Tuesday, January 14, 2025, at 6:45 p.m. Members present at Roll Call: Chair Tom Klitzka, Committee members Sheri Theis, John Moats, and Clerk Melissa Burns. Other guests present: Mayor Michelle Blanton.

Klitzka called the meeting to order at 6:45 p.m.

Moats motioned to approve the minutes from December 16, 2024. Seconded by Theis. Motion carried.

New Business:

a) AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE ZONING CODE TO MAKE CERTAIN CHANGES AND ADDITIONS TO THE CODE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

DISCUSSION: Klitzka stated this revision is to enact a Zoning Code to frame and adopt a plan for regulating the location and character of all buildings, construction and other uses of property within the City of Circleville. Theis noted a Public Hearing was held on November 4, 2024, with the Joint Planning and Zoning Commission and Council held another Public Hearing for the citizens on December 17, 2024.

MOTION - ROLL CALL – VOTE: Klitzka motioned to forward this Ordinance to the next Council meeting January 21, 2025, with a recommendation for passage. Seconded by Theis. Roll call (3 Yeas-0 Nays). Motion carried.

b) AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 07-39-2023 REMOVING POLICE CADETS FROM THE NON-BARGAINING UNIT COMPENSATION PLAN.

DISCUSSION: Mayor Blanton stated this Ordinance relates to the cadet program that passed last year and the reorganization of the police department. This Ordinance will set a rate of pay and cost of living increase as deemed necessary for the cadets.

MOTION - ROLL CALL – VOTE: Theis motioned to forward this Ordinance to the next Council meeting January 21, 2025, with a recommendation for passage. Seconded by Moats. Roll call (3 Yeas-0 Nays). Motion carried.

Other Business: None.

Moats motioned to adjourn the meeting at 6:54p.m. Seconded by Theis. Motion carried.
