

# RECORD OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 08-56-2024 Passed 08-06, 2024

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE TO SOLICIT BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER AFTER ADVERTISEMENT FOR THE TRAPPING AND DISPOSAL OF NUISANCE ANIMALS WITHIN THE CITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, various areas of the City have been experiencing difficulties with nuisance animals for groundhogs, racoons, skunks, possums and feral cats; and

**WHEREAS**, Council desires to assist its citizens within the City who have been experiencing difficulties with these nuisance animals by obtaining the services of a professional trapper who can trap and properly dispose of these animals; and

**WHEREAS**, obtaining the services of a trapper for these purposes will not be detrimental to the citizens of the City and ought to be done;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE, COUNTY OF PICKAWAY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I.** That the Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized and directed to solicit bids and to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement for the trapping and disposal of nuisance animals within the City, for groundhogs, racoons, skunks, possums and feral cats.

**SECTION II.** That the applicant must be licensed, bonded and insured.

**SECTION III.** That the cost for obtaining the services of a professional nuisance trapper is not to exceed Ten-Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) and shall be paid from Contract Services Account Number 101-0738-55010 .

**SECTION IV.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Circleville, such emergency arising out of the immediate need to address the trapping and disposal of nuisance animals within the City before additional damage and other harm occurs to the citizens of the City, so that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the mayor.
