Ordinance No. 9-68-2024

Passed 9-17, 2024

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY BECOME A RESIDENT OF THE CITY WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF APPOINTMENT TO THE POSITION OF DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY, UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS AND REPEALING ORDINANCE #08-52-2003 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Circleville is empowered by Ohio Revised Code 737.01 to waive the requirement that the Director of Public Safety be a resident of the City within six months after appointment; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE, COUNTY OF PICKAWAY, STATE OF OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Section 737.01, the Council of the City of Circleville hereby waives the requirement of residency of the position of the Director of Public Safety.

SECTION II. That Ordinance #08-52-2003 is hereby repealed and of no further force or effect.

SECTION III. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Circleville so that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
