

RECORD OF RESOLUTION

Resolution No. 11-90-2024

Passed 11-26, 2024

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO GRANT CARGILL INCORPORATED THE RIGHT TO INSTALL AND MAINTAIN A MODERNIZED UNLOADING SYSTEM AND NEW RAIL SIDINGS ACROSS THE LANDS OWNED BY THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE, NAMELY CANAL STREET AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Cargill, Incorporated is desirous of replacing an antiquated loading system with a modernized loading tower on Canal Street that increases efficiency and dust control and continued use of the railroad rail; and

WHEREAS, this would positively impact the public by reducing the amount of time for crossing closures and reducing the dust created by the current loading system; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Circleville believes the modernized loading system would be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Circleville and the same ought to be done.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE, COUNTY OF PICKAWAY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That Cargill Incorporated is hereby authorized to construct a new loading tower using footers and necessary appurtenances located in the existing Canal Street closed for public access and to construct new rail sidings as needed for the stacking and loading/unloading of rail cars. The location of said construction is to be in the currently closed to public use portions of Canal Street adjacent and contiguous to property currently owned and operated by Cargill Incorporated within the City's right-of-way.

SECTION II. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Circleville, such emergency arising out of the immediate need to grant this easement so as not to delay the installation of the modernized unloading tower, so that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its passage and approval by the mayor.
