Ordinance No. 05-36- 2023 Passed 5-16, 20 23

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ACCEPT AND ENTER INTO A SAFE STREETS FOR ALL (SS4A) GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (USDOT) FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION (FHWA) FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF AN ACTION PLAN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The City of Circleville recognizes the importance of safe streets and zero traffic fatalities within the entirety of this municipality; and

WHEREAS, the City of Circleville has committed to the creation of an Action Plan to accomplish safe streets for the benefit and well-being of all its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the USDOT Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has indicated its willingness to participate in this project by extending the City of Circleville a grant award in the amount of \$200,000.00 dollars;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Circleville, Pickaway County, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION I: That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into an SS4A Grant Agreement with the USDOT Federal Highway Administration for the awarded amount of \$200,000.00 dollars for the creation of an Action Plan to meet the goal of safe streets for all citizens.

SECTION II: That acceptance of the \$200,000.00 grant award and the execution of the Grant Agreement will require a City contribution of \$50,000.00, to be paid from account 206 of the Service Department Transportation Fund.

SECTION III: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Circleville, and the need to authorize the Director of Public Service to enter into the SS4A Grant Agreement prior to commission deadlines to accept this award,

SECTION IV: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law
