**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EDITING AND INCLUSION FOR CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF CIRCLEVILLE, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed which should be included in the Codified Ordinances of Circleville, Ohio;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE, COUNTY OF PICKAWAY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:**
