ORDINANCE NO. 66-49-92

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 303.99 TO CLARIFY THE PENALTY FOR JUNK MOTOR VEHICLE VIOLATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Circleville is empowered by statute to insure the regulation and removal of junk motor vehicles from the City streets; and

WHEREAS, in order to insure the orderly and expeditious removal of junk motor vehicles from the City, it is necessary to clarify the penalty relating to leaving junk motor vehicles in the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the City of Circleville as follows:


SECTION I That Section 303.99(a) (3) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Circleville are hereby amended so as to read as follows:


303.99(a) (2) JUNK MOTOR VEHICLES

Whoever violates Section 303.09 or 303.10 is guilty of a minor misdemeanor on the first offense; on a second offense within one year after the first offense, such person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree; on each subsequent offense within one year after the first offense such person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree. Anyone who violates Section 303.09 or 303.10 shall also be assessed any costs incurred by the municipality in disposing of such junk or abandoned motor vehicle, less any money accruing to the municipality from such disposal. (ORC 4513.99(D))

SECTION II That any ordinance or resolution in conflict with this Ordinance is hereby repealed and any portions of Section 303.99 not otherwise amended by this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION III That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Circleville and its inhabitants by reason of the necessity to insure the expeditious removal of junk motor vehicles from the City so that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.


