AN ORDINANCE FOR THE ADVERTISEMENT FOR THE ACQUISITION OF UNIFORMLY MARKED POLICE CRUISERS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, DIVISION OF POLICE and DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1: That the Director of Public Safety is authorized to advertise for and obtain bids to purchase two uniformly marked public safety vehicles for the Department of Public Safety, Division of Police

SECTION 2: That the Director of Public Safety is further authorized to contract for the purchase of such vehicles.

SECTION 3: That the Director of Public Safety be and hereby is authorized to utilize in said bidding currently owned public safety vehicles as trade-ins or if the Director of Public Safety deems appropriate is hereby authorized to sell one or more currently owned public safety vehicles to the highest independent bidder according to law.

SECTION 4: That the Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with any other bidding authority and through such bidding authority, purchase two (2) public safety vehicles conforming to the plans and specifications for such, which are on file and shall be available for review by prospective bidders in the Director of Public Safety's Office.

SECTION 5: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of public peace, health and safety of the City of Circleville, and its inhabitants, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
