ORDINANCE NO. 03-23-92

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 505.17 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE REGARDING MAINTAINING AND FEEDING OF PIGEONS IN THE CITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Circleville has determined that the keeping and harboring of pigeons in the municipality creates offensive and unsanitary conditions which are a menace to the health, comfort, and safety of the public; and

WHEREAS, it is therefore necessary for the protection of the public to prohibit the keeping or harboring of pigeons within the municipality;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Circleville as follows:

Section I: That Section 505.17 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Circleville is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

## 505.17 MAINTAINING OR FEEDING OF PIGEONS

- (a) No person shall knowingly do either of the following:
- 1). Keep, harbor, maintain or raise any pigeon.
  - 2). Keep or maintain any premises, or create a condition which provides food or feeding areas to pigeons within the City.

(b) This section prohibits keeping, maintaining or raising of any type of pigeon, including, but not limited to, raising and/or competition pigeons whether or not for profit.

(c) Whoever violates this Section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.

Section II: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Circleville for the reason that the presence of pigeons creates unsanitary conditions which are both offensive and potentially hazardous to the public by way of disease and otherwise, so that this ordinance shall take force and be in effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
