**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND ENTER INTO FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FUNDS THROUGH THE T-MOBILE HOMETOWN GRANT FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the T-Mobile Hometown Grant Fund, administers financial assistance for supporting a community project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Circleville desires financial assistance for improving Ted Lewis Park and purchasing a new four seasons shelter house.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE, COUNTY OF PICKAWAY, STATE OF OHIO AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I:** That the Circleville City Council concurs and approves filing applications for financial assistance from the T-Mobile Hometown Grant Fund.

**SECTION II.** That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized and directed to make applications with the T-Mobile Hometown Grant Fund and to execute any and all documents necessary for applying for and accepting said funds on the behalf of the City of Circleville and to execute any and all documents necessary to receive the same on behalf of the City of Circleville.

**SECTION III.** That the City of Circleville agrees to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed projects under the terms of the T-Mobile Hometown Grant Fund.

**SECTION IV.** That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the citizens of the City of Circleville; the emergency being to avoid unnecessary delay in the application process; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon the passage.
