Resolution Ordinance No. 06-52-94 Passed June 7 1994

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF IMPROVING PICKAWAY STREET, BETWEEN UNION STREET AND CORWIN STREET, INCLUDING INTERSECTIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council of the City of Circleville to improve Pickaway Street, between Union Street and Corwin Street, so as to provide a safe and adequate street for the general public; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service has caused plans, specifications, and estimates to be prepared for the said improvement; NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION I. That it is hereby determined to be necessary to improve Pickaway Street, between Union Street and Corwin Street, including intersections, by installing curb, gutter, sidewalk, storm sewer on Pickaway Street, in accordance with the plans and specifications hereinafter referred to.

SECTION II. That the plans, specifications, and the estimate of cost for the said improvement, heretofore caused to be prepared by the Director of Public Service and placed on file with the Clerk of this Council, be and the same hereby are approved.

SECTION III. That the grade of said street, after the said improvements have been completed, shall be as shown on the said plans and profiles identified as the 1994 Street Improvement Program, Contract #1, Pickaway Street Improvements.

That the entire cost of the said improvement, SECTION IV. consisting of curb, gutter, sidewalk, and storm sewer, on Pickaway Street shall be assessed upon the following described lots and lands, to wit: All said lots and lands abounding and abutting upon said improvement, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specifically benefited by the said improvements. Said assessments shall be levied by the following method, to wit: By the front foot of the property abounding and abutting upon said improvement; and shall be paid when levied in seven (7) annual installments, with interest on unpaid installments at the rate of seven percent (7%) provided, however, that the owner of any property assessed may, at his option, pay the assessment in cash within thirty (30) days after the passage of the ordinance levying such assessments. such assessments. The remainder of the cost of the said improvement, after the application of the assessments herein provided for, shall be provided from other funds available and appropriated for such purpose.

SECTION V. That the Director of Public Service of the said City be and hereby is authorized and directed to prepare an estimated assessment of the cost of said improvement based upon the estimate of cost heretofore filed with the Clerk of this Council, in accordance with the method of assessment set forth in this resolution, and showing thereon the amount of assessment, which shall be filed with the said Clerk and shall be available for public inspection.

SECTION VI. That, upon the filing of said estimated assessment, as herein before provided, the Clerk of this Council is authorized and directed to cause notice of the passage of this resolution and of the filing of said estimated assessment to be served upon the owners of all lots an lands to be assessed in the manner provided by law.

SECTION VII. That the Council declares this to be an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, such emergency arising out of the necessity to improve the said street for the safety and protection of the general public without undue delay in order to correct a situation now deemed undesirable; wherefore, this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
