

Ordinance No. 06-31- 2621 Passed 6-15-, 20 21

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ALLOW CONTRACTER TO EXCEED 10% OVER THE ESTABLISHED CONTRACTED BID AMOUNT FOR THE WOODLAND DRIVE PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council by ordinance has previously authorized the Director of Public Service to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the Woodland Drive Project; and

WHEREAS, during the project it was determined that Woodland Drive and Folsom Avenue would need to be paved due to the deterioration of the roadway while doing the project; and in doing so, this would increase the cost to over 10% of the contracted bid amount; and

WHEREAS, it therefore necessary for Council to approve these additional expenditures;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION I. That Council hereby approves the additional expenditures which are in excess of ten percent (10%) of the contracted amount for the Woodland Drive Project.

SECTION II. That the cost of this project shall be paid out of the Street Improvement Fund 206 in the amount not to exceed \$84,000.

SECTION III. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the citizens of the City of Circleville; the emergency being to avoid unnecessary delay in the application process; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon the passage
