RECORD OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 10 - 50 -Passed A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE YOUTH LEAGUES TO UTILIZE TED LEWIS PARK FOR THE PURPOSE OF PARKING VEHICLES DURING THE 2021 PUMPKIN SHOW AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. WHEREAS, the City of Circleville Youth Leagues, consisting of Circleville Girls Softball, Tiger Girls Softball, Little League Baseball, Circleville Youth Soccer League and Pee Wee Football, desire to use Ted Lewis Park to park vehicles during the 2021 Pumpkin Show; and WHEREAS, the youth leagues have agreed upon a set price to charge for vehicle parking; and WHEREAS, the youth leagues have agreed upon a yearly rotating schedule of the days in which each league will provide parking and keeping the proceeds from their designated day; and WHEREAS, the youth leagues will share the cost of renting portable restrooms placed at Ted Lewis Park during Pumpkin Show; and WHEREAS, the youth leagues have agreed to meet the Sunday morning after Pumpkin Show to clear the park of any debris left over and return the park to the condition in which it was found; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE, COUNTY OF PICKAWAY, STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS: SECTION I. That the City of Circleville Youth Leagues be, and is hereby, authorized to use Ted Lewis Park beginning on Tuesday, October 19, 2021 through Saturday, October 23, 2021 for the purpose of vehicle parking for the 2021 Pumpkin Show. SECTION II. That as a condition precedent to Section I, the event sponsor shall maintain a Two Million dollar (\$2,000,000) Liability Insurance Certificate for the protection of the City of Circleville, Ohio, indemnifying and saving harmless the said City from any liability that may arise or accrue by reason of the temporary closing/use of the street(s) or other thoroughfare, and the event sponsor shall present a copy, naming the City as an additional insured, to the Auditor of the City of Circleville, Ohio for approval prior to said event. **SECTION III.** That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the citizens of the City of Circleville; the emergency being to avoid unnecessary delay in the application process; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon the passage.
