AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 139.02 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE ESTABLISHING THE COMPOSITION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES AND CREATING THE POSITION OF UTILITIES OPERATION MANAGER WITHIN SUCH DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Circleville is empowered by statute to establish the composition of the employees within the Department of Public Utilities: and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Utilities includes the division of water and sewer and the utilities office; and

WHEREAS, to improve the efficient and effective operation of said Department of Public Utilities, the city has determined a need to establish the position of Utilities Operation Manager within the Department of Public Utilities to oversee the day to day operations of all divisions within this department and to amend Section 139.02 of the Codified Ordinances to include this position in the composition of the department.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Circleville, Pickaway County, Ohio, as follows:

That Section 139.02 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Circleville is hereby amended to include the position of Utilities Operations Manager to the table of organization.

SECTION II. That there is hereby established the position of Utilities Operation Manager within the Public Department of Utilities which shall be a full-time, nonunion, classified position and be paid under Pay Grade 7 of the Uniform Compensation Plan for the Non-Bargaining Unit Employees upon passage of this ordinance.

SECTION III. That any ordinance or resolution in conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed.

SECTION IV. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period permitted by law.
