Ordinance No. 10-60- 2021 Passed 10-19-, 20 21

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL REVENUE FUND KNOW AS THE "COVID RELATED FEDERAL GRANTS FUND" AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, in accordance to the guidance of the Auditor of the State of Ohio Bulletin No. 2021-004. Additionally, Ohio Revised Code section 5705.09 requires subdivisions to establish separate funds for each class of revenue derived from a source other than the general property tax, which the law requires to be used for a particular purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Circleville, Ohio as follows:

SECTION I: There is hereby established a special revenue fund to be known as the "COVID Related Federal Grants Fund" fund number 257 under the provisions of Section 5705.09 of the Ohio Revised Code. The necessity of establishing a COVID Related Federal Grants Fund is to provide for the accounting of revenue and expenditures from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA).

SECTION II: That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Circleville, Ohio; the reason for the emergency being the need to comply with guidance set forth by the Auditor of the State of Ohio through Bulletin No. 2021-004 and the Ohio Revised Code section 5705.09 concerning the need to establish separate funds for each class of revenue derived from a source other than the general property tax, which the law requires to be used for a particular purpose. Therefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
