Ordinance No. 12-68-202

Passed 12-7-, 2021

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A SPONSORSHIP AGREEMENT WITH THE APPALACHIA OHIO ALLIANCE.

WHEREAS, the City of Circleville intends to apply for Water Pollution Loan Fund (WPLF) funding for the construction of said improvement of WWTP Improvements NRD: and

WHEREAS, the City of Circleville recognizes the importance of and supports the conservation and enhancement of natural resources such as the Scioto River; and

WHEREAS, the Appalachia Ohio Alliance has proposed acquiring, restoring and protecting valuable water resources through the Cooks Creek Addition Scioto River Flyway Addition project for a sponsorship amount not to exceed \$3,430,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the City of Circleville intends to participate in the Water Resource Restoration Sponsorship Program (WRRSP) in association with the WPLF to assist the Appalachia Ohio Alliance in the acquisition, restoration and protection of the Cooks Creek Addition Scioto River Flyway Addition project up to the aforementioned sponsorship amount.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION I: That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a Sponsorship Agreement with the Appalachia Ohio Alliance.

SECTION II. A copy of the full agreement is attached as Exhibit "A"

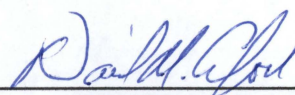
SECTION III. That the participation in the Water Resource Restoration Sponsor Program in association with the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund be and is hereby authorized.

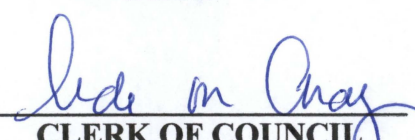
SECTION IV. That the proposed WRRSP project identified above is hereby included in said authorization.

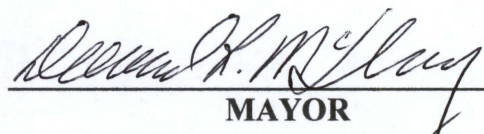
SECTION VI. That this ordinance shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

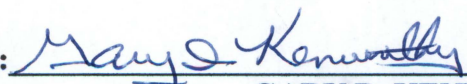
