Ordinance No. 12-25-2621Passed 12-30-, 20 21

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH U.T.E. (UTILITY TRUCK EQUIPMENT) TO PURCHASE A USED 2014 INSULTED 40 FT. TELESCOPIC AERIAL PLATFORM LIFT, OBVIATING FORMAL BIDDING AND ADVERSTING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Circleville's 1993 bucket truck was damaged beyond repair; and

WHEREAS, the piece of equipment is crucial to the maintenance of the City's traffic and signalization infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, this equipment is specialized and is not readily available; and

WHEREAS, due to the emergency need to replace this vehicle it is necessary to enter into the contract for the purchase of a replacement vehicle without formal bidding and advertising as permitted by O.R.C. §735.051;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Circleville, County of Pickaway, State of Ohio, as follows:

SECTION I: That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement to purchase Stock # 2926 2014 SST-4-EIH from UTE (Utility Truck Equipment) for \$45,000.00 without the need of formal bidding and advertising due to the real and present emergency arising in connection with the operation and maintenance of the department of public service.

SECTION II: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the citizens of the City of Circleville, such emergency arising out of the immediate need to obtain a replacement bucket truck for the Department of Public Service so that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its passage and approval by the mayor.
