AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 741.51 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE RELATING TO THE ALLOCATION OF FUNDS DEPOSITED INTO THE CIRCLEVILLE CABLE TELEVISION SPECIAL REVENUE FUND #211, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Circleville has previously established a special revenue fund known as the Circleville Cable Television special Revenue Fund #211, which is funded by the semi-annual franchise fee payments, as well as advertising, grants and all other funds generated by the Cable Television Affairs Department; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 741.51 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Circleville, fifty percent (50%) of all the semi-annual franchise fee payments as well as advertising, grants and other funds generated by the Cable Television Department are currently allocated to this Circleville Cable Television Special Revenue Fund; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council at this time to temporarily re-allocate the disbursement of these cable television revenues between the general operating expenses and the Cable Television Special Revenue Fund; and

WHEREAS, the re-allocation of these revenues is in the best interests of the City of Circleville and the same ought to be done.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Circleville, Pickaway County, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION I. That 741.51(a) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Circleville is hereby amended so as to provide that sixteen percent (16%) of all semi-annual franchise fee payments, as well as all advertising, grants and all other funds generated by the Cable Television Affairs Department, and all other revenue (exclusive of legal fees) received from the franchise in connection with the negotiation or renegotiation of the franchise or its enforcement or as settlement of any claims shall be deposited into the Circleville Cable Television Special Revenue Fund #211.

SECTION II. That the provisions in this ordinance will be for a one year period beginning January 1, 2019 and shall revert back to the 2005 allocation formula commencing January 1, 2020.

SECTION III. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Circleville, such emergency arising out of the immediate need for additional funds for the General Operating fund of the City to maintain necessary services for the citizens, so that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
