AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH OHIO FIRST RESPONDER GRANTS, LLC TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT GRANT PROJECTS TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE ACQUISITION OF A NEW FIRE TRUCK AND A NEW AMBULANCE FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY-DIVISION OF FIRE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety, Division of Fire and Emergency Medical Services is in need of a new fire engine and a new ambulance to be used by the departments; and

WHEREAS, in order to fund the purchase of these vehicles, the Safety Director is desirous of obtaining the services of Ohio First Responder Grants, LLC to prepare and submit grant applications to the Fiscal Year 2019 Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, employing Ohio First Responder Grants, LLC for this purpose is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Circleville and the same ought to be done.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Circleville, Pickaway County, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION I. That the Safety Director is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Ohio First Responder Grants, LLC to prepare and submit grant applications to the Fiscal Year 2019 Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program to assist in funding the purchase of a new fire engine and a new ambulance to be utilized by the Department of Public Safety-Division of Fire and Emergency Medical Services of the City. The terms of this agreement shall be in accordance with the Contract attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION II. That the compensation to Ohio First Responder Grants, LLC for the preparation and submission of the grant applications for the purchase of these vehicles shall be paid from the appropriated funds of the Safety Forces .5% Income Tax Fund 212 in an amount not to exceed \$5,000.00.

SECTION III. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Circleville, such emergency arising out of the immediate need to prepare and submit grant applications for the purchase of these two vehicles within the time deadline for submission of such grant applications to the Fiscal Year 2019 Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program, so that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
