AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 10-63-2018 AND SECTION 105.01 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE SO AS TO TRANSFER CENSUS BLOCK NO. 391290201001022 FROM THE SECOND WARD INTO THE THIRD WARD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in order to comply with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 731.06, council has previously modified the ward boundary lines to make each ward substantially equal in population; and

WHEREAS, after modifying these ward boundary lines, it has been determined that the liquor permits of an owner of a downtown business changed by this redistricting from the third ward to the second ward will be adversely affected; and

WHEREAS, to avoid undue hardship to this business, council desires to modify the previously approved ward boundaries so as to transfer census block No. 391290201001022 from the second ward back into the third ward; and

WHEREAS, this modification will not substantially change the equality of the city wards as to population and the same ought to be done.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Circleville, Pickaway County, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION I. That Ordinance No. 10-63-18 and Section 105.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Circleville are hereby amended so as to transfer census block 391290201001022 from the second ward back into the third ward so that the ward boundaries are hereby changed to be in accordance with the map attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A", and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION II. That the Clerk of this Council shall provide a certified copy of this Ordinance to the County Auditor and the County Board of Elections so as to insure that this modification is duly noted on the official ward map of the City.

SECTION III. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Circleville, such emergency arising out of the immediate need to modify the ward boundaries as noted herein to avoid unnecessary hardship to the affected business involved so that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
