AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER TO SUPPLY HIGHWAY SALT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE OR TO PURCHASE HIGHWAY SALT THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Service will be using highway salt for de-icing city streets during the winter months; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City of Circleville to provide safe city streets; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION I. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to advertise for bids and enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder for supplying highway salt or to purchase highway salt through the Ohio Department of Transportation Cooperative Purchasing Program.

SECTION II. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
