

Ordinance No. 03 - 14 - 2003

Passed March 18, 2003

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF CIRCLEVILLE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE (CEMS) CHIEF OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE AND SETTING A REASONABLE COMPENSATION FOR THIS POSITION.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Circleville is authorized by statute to establish employee positions for the City and to set compensation therefore; and

WHEREAS, the City of Circleville, Ohio has determined a need to establish the position of full time CEMS Chief; and

WHEREAS, the same will not be detrimental to the general interests of the City and the same ought to be done.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE, STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That there is hereby created the position of full time CEMS Chief to handle such duties and responsibilities as assigned by the Mayor.

SECTION II. That the compensation for the position of full time CEMS Chief is hereby established at an amount not to exceed Forty Two Thousand Dollars (\$42,000.00), payable annually, commencing April 1, 2003.

SECTION III. That the position of full time CEMS Chief shall be a non-union, unclassified, appointed position and shall be paid from the Safety Fund Account No. 212.0153.51000.

SECTION IV. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period permitted by law.
