A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE/ UTILITIES AND ITS ASSIGNS TEMPORARY ACCESS EASEMENTS ON PRIVATE PROPERTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING, REPAIRING OR REPLACING WATER OR SANITARY SEWER SERVICES TO THE PRIMARY DWELLING OF RESIDENTS WITHIN A PROJECT LOCATION WHEN SUCH HAS BEEN DEEMED APPROPRIATE AND IS IN ACCORDANCE WITH FEDERAL, STATE OR LOCAL LAW AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Circleville Department of Public Utilities is compelled by State, Local, and Federal laws and regulations to provide water and sewer services to its residents; and

WHEREAS, changes to, and enforcement of, those existing laws and regulations has necessitated the replacement or establishment of services within the City; and

WHEREAS, the period of installation and, or replacement of existing service connections is determined by the availability of funding for the implementation of such projects; and

WHEREAS, the acquisition of individual temporary easements would place undue time constraints on the acquisition of such funding; and

WHEREAS, the construction of new water and sewer services is expressly for the purpose of better providing for the health and welfare of the citizens of Circleville.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE, COUNTY OF PICKAWAY, STATE OF OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: That the Department of Public Utilities of the City of Circleville is hereby granted blanket temporary easement for the construction of and, or replacement of water and sewer services to all primary dwellings identified as requiring such construction for the purpose of improving the health, safety, and welfare of the City of Circleville as compelled by Federal, State and Local law, and that every effort shall be made to return the area disturbed within such temporary easement to its original condition.

SECTION II. That the cost of the construction of and, or replacement of new service connections shall be paid by the City of Circleville.

SECTION III. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the citizens of the City of Circleville; the emergency being to avoid unnecessary delay in constructing, repairing or replacing water or sanitary sewer services to the citizens of Circleville, wherefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effective immediately upon its passage.
